Brief Project Description:

The proposed project entails the stabilization of gully beds and banks, partial reclamation of eroded surfaces around the gully sites, construction of hydraulic structures which consists of culverts, catch pits, rip-rap and re-enforced concrete rectangular channels along the key roads to intercept and divert run-off as well as the rehabilitation of existing central drain which discharges run-off into Maboro River. The gully has developed into two stretches, the first stretch covers about 21,456m² and the second stretch covers about 4,254 m² in Ankpa LGA, Kogi State.
